Usage

```
find_api(pattern, refresh = FALSE)
```

Arguments

<code>pattern</code>	A string to search for. This string is converted to lowercase before comparison.
<code>refresh</code>	Whether to force a refresh of the APIs.guru API list.

Value

A tibble with columns `title`, `provider`, `service`, and `apid_url`.
